



Learn Polish from home

Have you been wanting to learn to speak Polish but [our classes](#) didn't work with your schedule? Great news! Thanks

(at least in part) to the polite, but persistent calls of PYTown Team Member Carol Papalas, all of our regional Ohio public libraries now offer Mango Polish language lessons via remote access from your home computer. All you need is a library card to get started.

While the terminology may differ from library to library, you would generally

- go to the website of your library, Databases, Language, Mango Languages,
- create your profile using your email address and library card number. (We have found the reference librarians to be very helpful if you have any questions or problems in this regard.)
- Select Courses, Polish, Basic, and start Lesson 1. You will see vocabulary words in English and Polish and will hear its pronunciation in Polish; you can repeat the pronunciation as many times as you wish.
- Mango will quiz you to test your memory of the words you have learned.

If you don't have time to finish a lesson, no problem - the next time you log in, you can simply resume your lesson. Mango also offers a nice "Translate" feature.
